**GCSE and A Level Music and Drama Trip to *Wicked*
Tuesday 30 April 2024 at the Victoria Apollo Theatre, London**

We are delighted to inform you that the Cox Green School Music and Drama Departments are organising a trip to watch *Wicked* at the Victoria Apollo Theatre in London on the evening of Tuesday 30 April 2024. As well as being an exciting opportunity to see this amazing musical (written to serve as a prequel to *The Wizard of Oz*), this ties in to our GCSE and A Level Music and Drama courses.

The cost of this trip is £42.25 and there are 30 places available which will be issued on a first come first served basis by payment via your child's sQuid account. sQuid will be open for payment from 6pm this Sunday, 17 March 2024 (closing 10pm on Wednesday 20 March 2024).

We will travel to London by coach, departing school at 4.45pm, and will return at approximately 11.30pm and we ask you to make collection arrangements for your child at this time.

Students are to be back at school for 4.30pm but are welcome to remain in school until this time should they wish to do so and may therefore choose to bring a change of clothes to school with them. The dress code for this theatre trip is smart-casual (tracksuits and short tops/skirts are not allowed). We also ask that students bring enough food for the evening or money to visit the local shops between school and 4.30pm. As a reminder no nuts or foods containing nuts are allowed.

Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
