## Ski Trip to Artesina, Italy — Saturday 15 — Saturday 22 February 2025

Following on from the great success of previous ski trips, we are delighted to inform you that we are organising a skiing trip to Italy. This trip is open to students of all skiing abilities, from advanced to new beginners and will give them a sporting opportunity that they might not otherwise have, develop new skills, friendships and memories.

The trip will take place during the February 2025 half term break, from Saturday 15 - Saturday 22 February 2025 and is open to all students from the current academic years' 7 - 12. All students attending this trip must be on the school roll at the time of the trip and will require a valid passport and E/GHIC. Students will be expected to attend school on the Monday morning after the trip returns.

The cost of the trip is £1,315 per student and they will also require funds to purchase refreshments whilst on the coach journey, plus any spending money whilst in resort.
