#### Why are we doing this trip?

- To enable students to gain a realistic and emotional understanding of the Holocaust
- To understand the human cost to war
- To gain an understanding of the events
  - that have shaped history
- To help GCSE and A-Level studies







08:30 Arrive at school as normal (in own/travel clothes).

Take luggage to Room H9.

Register with group leader – passport/GHIC check.

Students will need money for lunches/snacks, gifts, etc.




#### **Spending Money/Valuables/Passports**

- Spending money will need to be exchanged for the Polish Zloty prior to the trip (£-Sterling for UK airport)
- Students will hold onto their own money
- Passports and E/GHIC's will be collected and held by a member of staff during travel
- Students are advised against taking any valuable items
   lost or stolen items cannot be replaced by the school
- Mobile phones/cameras may be taken (at own risk) for taking photos, but due to GDPR and other parent/carer permissions, students are NOT to upload anything to social media



- Phone the school in the first instance during office hours
- If outside of office hours, please use the emergency number (this will be provided the week of the trip)
- Students are not to contact home directly





- Contact details in case of emergency, we shall use your child's Priority 1 contact, as confirmed on the most recent OA4 form that you returned to school (copy in your envelopes)
- Check these details are accurate these are the details used should we need to contact you
- Please clearly mark any amendments and return to Mrs Feetham, by Friday 13 December 2024 or hand in now before you leave



#### Medicines/Overseas Agreement

- Please complete the 'Residential Trip Medicine Form' for any medication your child will require during the time of this trip (this applies to both prescribed and over-the-counter medicine)
- Any medication is to be handed in to Mrs Feetham by <u>Monday 13 January, in original boxes and clearly labelled</u>
   Only provide enough medication for the duration of the trip.
   Please check airline liquid allowance.
- We will only hold onto medication listed on the Residential Trip - Medicine Form
- Students are NOT to carry any medication (except for Inhalers/Auto-Injectors/Insulin)
  Emergency medication must be carried in hand luggage.



- Your own passport and E/GHIC
- Toiletries please adhere to airline guidance and rules
- Clothing please pack appropriate clothing
  - remember where we are going to
- Warm jumper/fleece and coat/rain jacket
- Hat and gloves it may be very cold!
- Sensible/comfortable footwear for walking
- Baggage allowance:
  - 23kg per person in the hold
  - one small piece of hand luggage
- Students must be able to carry their own luggage!
