**Year 13 BTEC Health and Social Care Trip
Unit 2 Working in Health and Social Care - Grade Booster – Wednesday 29 November 2023**

I am writing to inform you that we have organised a trip to London on Wednesday 29 November 2023 for our BTEC Health and Social Care students for a cinema workshop. This workshop takes place at the Vue Cinema, Westfield, Stratford City, and is designed and delivered by experienced teacher and examiner presenters, of all whom have a deep understanding of what students need to focus on in order to succeed in the 2024 exams.

The workshops will provide revision sessions of each component of the course as well as provide opportunities for students to develop exam skills and techniques, including how to form model answers to unit 2 exam questions. These workshops will be hosted by the following presenters:

- Liz Blamire: An experienced senior examiner, author and SSAT Accredited Lead Practitioner, who has taught Health and Social Care in FE and secondary schools.
- Lynne Fountain: An experienced examiner and moderator, who has taught in FE and secondary schools and held a variety of roles for the Department of Education, charity sector, youth justice and a large children's hospital.
- Rachel Lang: Having taught in secondary schools, Rachel has also been an examiner in Australia for Health and Human Development, and has a bachelor degree in Health Sciences and Education.

The cost for this event is £36.60 per student and we ask you to please make payment via your child's sQuid account which is now open for payment (closing 10pm on Wednesday 15 November 2023). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost, if your child is unable to attend.

We will travel to London by train and students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 8.00am where we ask students to purchase their train ticket directly on the day. We aim to return to Maidenhead train station at 5.00pm and we ask collection arrangements are made for this time. Students are advised to bring a packed lunch, drinks and snacks to last the day.

If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
