Year 13 History Trip to Winchester's Military Museum – Friday 19 January 2024

Students studying A Level History have the opportunity to visit the Winchester's Military Museum in Winchester on Friday 19 January 2024. This visit supports the delivery of the 'British Experience of Warfare c.1790-1918' module as part of the Edexcel A Level History syllabus.

Students will be able to explore the museum and visit many exhibits, which will deepen their understanding and knowledge of the historical period 1790-1918. This will directly support the delivery of the A Level syllabus and will help to prepare students for their exams in the summer.

The cost of this trip is £10 per student and if you would like your child to attend, please make payment via your sQuid account. You will be able to do this from today (closing: 10pm on Monday 11 December 2023). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost of the trip, if your child is unable to go.

We will travel to Winchester by school mini bus, departing school at 8.30am, and returning to school for 3.00pm. Students can wear their own appropriate clothes on this trip and are to bring a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day, or money to purchase food at the on-site café. As a reminder, in line with school policy, mobile phones are not permitted on any school trips or visits.
