Year 12 and 13 A Level Compulsory Geography Field Trip to Selsey – Tuesday 1 October 2024

As part of the A Level Geography course, students are to complete four days of compulsory fieldwork in order to experience 'practical geography' and have hands on experience of collecting and processing data, in order to come to a substantiated conclusion to answer an enquiry question.

We have arranged for our Geography students to visit Selsey for their field trip, as this provides an ideal location to study coastal processes as well as human impacts in the town. Students will be divided into groups to complete data collection at sites, with each group led by a Geography teacher.

The cost of this trip is £6.00 per student and to confirm your child's place, we ask you to please make payment via your sQuid account. This will be open from today (closing: 10pm on Wednesday 18 September 2024).

We will leave school at 8.30am and travel to Selsey by school minibus, returning for 4.00pm (traffic dependant). Please arrange collection of your student for this time. Students should wear appropriate clothing and footwear suitable for the coast and weather conditions on the day (including being on the beach). Students should bring with them a full pencil case, including pencils as they will be drawing, along with a packed lunch, snacks and drinks to last the day. Students may wish to bring some money as there may be an opportunity to have some free time after lunch, before returning. Please note, eating and drinking on the minibus is not allowed and products containing nuts are not allowed.

If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
