**KS5 – Physics in Action – Monday 18 November 2024**

We have arranged a fantastic opportunity to take our KS5 Physics students to the Physics in Action lectures, at the Emmanuel Centre in London, on Monday 18 November 2024. Five sessions of phenomenal physics will be brought to you by the brightest lights in the field in 2024. It will be a day full of inspiration, challenge and experimentation across the breadth of physics. In addition, there will be a special session on examination success to provide students with the tools to excel. We strongly recommend attendance to this event for students' future career choices.

The cost of this trip is £26. There are 30 places available and will be booked on a first come, first served basis, via your child's sQuid account. Please make payment via your sQuid account and you will be able to do this from 7pm on Sunday 6 October 2024 (closing at 10pm on Wednesday 9 October 2024). Please note that due to the nature of this trip, we are unable to refund the cost if your child is unable to go.

Students are to meet at the front of Maidenhead train station at 8.45am on the day, where they can purchase their travel ticket directly. The cost of this ticket is (approx.) £34 and we ask that students pay this directly on the day. We will then travel to the venue by train and tube, and expect to return to Maidenhead train station at approximately 5.30pm (please arrange collection of your child accordingly). Should students wish to remain in London and make their own way home, please complete the permissions when prompted on your sQuid account. Students can wear smart casual wear on this trip and are to either bring their own lunch with them or bring money to purchase food during the day (please note: products containing nuts are not allowed).

Should the school need to contact you in an emergency, we will use contact details supplied on your most recent OA4 Form (off-site activity form). If there are any changes to the details on this form, including any medical or dietary requirements, it is the parent/carer responsibility to inform the school.
