As you may be aware, the school was inspected by Ofsted on the 19th and 20th March, and I wanted to share an update with you regarding the outcome. Since our last full inspection in 2015, our teachers and staff have been working incredibly hard to continue to embed good practices that allow us to provide the best possible teaching and learning experience for our entire school community. As a result, inspectors have rated us 'Good' in our personal development and Sixth Form provisions. However, some of our strategies are still fairly new and have not yet had time to fully embed and achieve the full impact we are aiming for. Because of this, inspectors have given an overall rating of 'Requires Improvement'.

Though this judgement is not what we had hoped, inspectors made many positive remarks throughout the report, indicating the School already has many strong and effective practices in place. We are confident that our ongoing plans for improvement will enable us to achieve our ambitions for delivering a high-quality education for all our pupils, and we look forward to welcoming Ofsted back in the future.

We are pleased to be able to offer an information evening where we will be able to share more on our plans for the next academic year and beyond. This will take place on Wednesday 17th July 5.00-6.30 pm. Should you be unable to attend or have any questions, please do get in touch.

The Library Service will be updating and streamlining the Library Management System next week. The migration is due to take place from 1st to 8th July, during which time the system will work in “offline mode”. Libraries will continue to open to the public as normal and customers will be able to borrow and return items. Digital services such as Public PCs and Public WiFi will remain available.

Borrowbox, Britannica, Kanopy, Libby and Pressreader will also remain available, although to retain access to BorrowBox and PressReader during the offline period, please log in using your library card number by 2pm on Sunday 30th June. Please note that some services will be temporarily suspended. This will include placing reservations, renewing items, searching the catalogue, making library payments and using the Library App. The library will still continue to take council payments and assist customers with Council Services.
